## MEETING MINUTES

**Minutes of Regular Meeting of Pigeon Lake Protection and Rehabilitation District**  
**September 2, 2020** Clintonville Community Center, 30 S. Main St, Clintonville, WI

1. Call to Order, 6:45 PM--Open Meeting Statement made by Chair Kussman
2. Roll Call: Present--Honish, Huntley, Kussman, Lundt, Radtke, Strey-Hirt, Pahl. Counsel Keith A. Steckbauer also present
3. Approval of Agenda: **M/S/P Honish, Huntley**
4. Treasurers Report: **M/S/P acceptance--Pahl, Strey-Hirt**
5. Committee Reports:
  - a. County Liaison--Kussman--No Report
  - b. City Liaison--Strey-Hirt--No Report
  - c. Operations/Weed-Cutting Manager: Radtke
  - d. Website/Cloud Update: Good discussion of PLPRD Facebook page and its importance for public awareness of our work; Lundt indicated willingness to work on keeping updated, if he could get editing privileges
  - e. PLPRD Grants: Pahl reported that in consultation with Ted Johnson of DNR he submitted preliminary "Major Lake Management Planning Grant" proposal to DNR, which would fund \$20,000 of a \$30,000 project--to include ways to reduce Aquatic Invasive Species (plant survey to document impact /benefits of draw-down), basometric mapping of lake to ascertain actual depth, and other measures to improve water quality--which may involve partial draw downs in winter, aeration, riparian zone repair, and collaborative work with area farmers and (eventually) with Marion water treatment plant. RFP to Lake Management companies (would follow approval of final grant proposal, due November 1. **M/S/P, Pahl/Strey-Hirt: PLPRD to submit grant for Updating Lake Management Plan from 2015.**
  - f. Fish--Radtke--reported on restocking plans, and carp removal--scheduled by DNR for October
6. Old Business: Mathew's Bay Fishing Dock Replacement--work to be underway next week
7. New Business: None
8. Public Comment: Honish remarked that lake draw down during winter could lead to fish kill, and levels would need to be very carefully monitored
