7. Old Business
 - a. Sale of old conveyor (email aquarius) Yes Travis said they still are telling people we have it for sale. Prickette suggested sending new pictures now that it has been power washed.
 - b. Dredging, (disposing of spoils) Prickette has a lot of material to go over to determine the steps we need to take. Prickette will email information on dredging by other districts to committee members to look over and gain a perspective on what it entails.
8. New business
 - a. Jason Breeggemann (new DNR fisheries biologist) Jason Breeggemann introduced himself and talked about his education and his new role at the DNR, We look forward to working with him in the future.
 - b. Discuss new rule of DNR dredging? Dredging in the past allowed Riparian Owners to dredge by hand 30 ft, the department is announcing its intention to issue a statewide waterway general permit (GP) for dredging of lakes and streams in Wisconsin. Once in place, the permit will be valid for five years and will allow applicants to apply for coverage under the permit to dredge up to 25 cubic yards from streams and inland lakes and up to 100 cubic yards from the Great Lakes if the project meets all eligibility criteria and conditions.
